

Letter from the President/CEO

Dear CCOC Investors,

As the President/CEO of the Clayton Chamber of Commerce, I have never been prouder of this staff, our volunteers, and the business community of Clayton. There was not one business or person that did not face challenges, changes, and even devastation in some cases due to this 2020 pandemic. I witnessed layoffs, furloughs, temporary and permanent closings, shut downs, loss of revenue, and many others of which your Chamber was certainly not immune. But I also witnessed determination, resilience, collaboration, community support, innovation, perseverance, adaptation, new business openings, and exciting plans for future growth. Zoom has become a noun, verb, adjective, and a new way of conducting business.

The Clayton Chamber of Commerce, while facing its own challenges, was still able to sustain a strong path of growth, continue to work towards many of our strategic goals, and provide valuable resources to our investors. Some of the key highlights of 2020 include:

- The newly formed Clayton Chamber Foundation created the Small Business Recovery Grant Fund and distributed \$27,000 to 15 small businesses in the Clayton area.
- The Clayton Chamber of Commerce's Economic Development Committee's Community Highlight video titled "Think Clayton", which was released at this meeting last year, won a Communication Excellence Award from the Carolina's Association of Chamber of Commerce Executives.
- State, regional, county, and local partnerships continued to work toward initiatives including responsible growth, infrastructure, business attraction and retention, workforce development, and education. New partnerships and initiatives were formed.
- CCOC's Legislative and Governmental Affairs Committee led the charge this
 election season by completing a voter resources webpage stocked full of
 important information surrounding voting, creating a political forum video titled
 "Platforms at the Podium" which featured candidates and their platforms for
 local county and state races, and completing a county-wide "Get out and Vote"
 campaign. Our goal was to inform and educate.

- Behind the scenes, the Clayton Chamber continued to represent this business community through many different local, regional, and state organizations or events
- CCOC was also able to review our investors' needs and add new benefits for all CCOC investors, including the brand-new Clayton Job Board located on our website.

As the recovery process continues, The Clayton Chamber of Commerce continues to keep its hand on the pulse of our business community and provide updates and resources as needed. In 2021 we are going to **REACH** to new heights.

- Hosted a Platforms at the Podium live event in February of 2020 for the Johnston County Board of Education Primary election candidates. This panel event was free and open to the public.
- Interviewed candidates and developed a Platforms at the Podium 3-part video series for the local and state races including NC House, NC Senate and Superintendent of Public Instruction and the Johnston County Races of Board of Education and County Commissioner.
